

Australian Team Agreement

Developed November 2025

Representing Australia and the disc golf community on the world stage is a great honor. Australian Disc Golf holds high expectations of all representatives to ensure team harmony, event preparedness and overall success of the campaign.

All players and reserves selected for the 2026 Australian Disc Golf team must agree to:

- Behave according to the <u>ADG Respect Agreement</u> throughout the campaign this includes behaviour towards other Team members, competitors, the public and environment.
- Play a minimum of 5 PDGA sanctioned events between January 2026 and July 2026, including at least 1 x ADG major.
- Stay at the Team Accommodation for the entire event including official practice days.
- Arrive in Vilnius a minimum of 2 days prior to the first official practice day to help overcome jet lag.
- Not partake in any competition play within 3 days of the first official practice day to mitigate injury.
- Understand that play time for each individual will vary according to the needs and performance of the Team, other team members, and the individual.
- Follow all reasonable direction from Team Support and Management staff throughout the campaign
- Be active and responsive on the official Team communication channels throughout the campaign
- Caddy as required throughout the event for other team members
- Share and promote the Team via social media
- Be a certified PDGA Official at the time of event play
- Complete all necessary substance and integrity assessments as directed by the LOC, WFDF and AFDA.
- Pay all fees and payments in a timely manner.

All Players are required to fund their travel to the event. Some costs may be offset via Team and Player fundraising efforts. These efforts will be determined by the Team. The expected travel costs include:
