Aussie Disc Golf Day 2026

Celebrating 50 Years of Flight

When: 19-20 September 2026

Where: a disc golf course or park near you

Aussie Disc Golf Day is Australia's biggest disc golf participation event: a nationwide virtual tournament held simultaneously at clubs and courses across the country. Every year, on the same weekend in September, players of all skill levels tee off together in their own communities and their scores roll up into a single national leaderboard. It is competitive, community-focused, and completely free to enter for clubs running an event.

Information for Clubs and TD's

- The aim of the event is for organisers to keep costs to a minimum and encourage participation including new players playing in their first tournament.
- Australian Disc Golf are covering the PDGA sanctioning costs for all ADGD events.
- Event organisers will only need to budget for a \$3.50 event-based fee per player, which will be invoiced by ADG after the event.
- Events can be held on either Saturday 19th or Sunday 20th September and need to be 2 rounds on a course with a minimum of 13 holes using PDGA online scoring.
- ADG will provide a the 50 Years of Flight lapel/bag pin, free for all registered participants.
- For scores to be included in the national event, 3 propagators must finish the event.
- All ADG tour divisions should be offered.
- ADG will provided prizes for overall division winners.
- TD's are encouraged to offer prizes or trophies for the winner of each division and a payout to the at least the top 20% of all open divisions.
- There will be no AGD tour points awarded.
- TD's are the backbone of our sport and this is a great event to encourage a new TD to try out the role. The ADG's [TD Mentoring Program](#) offers a framework to guide and support new TDs, ensuring they have the skills and confidence to succeed on their own.

Registering an ADGD Event

1. If you've never run an event before or haven't TD'ed recently, please read through the [ADG Tournament Directors Guide](#) to make sure you are up to speed with all the latest requirements including Working With Children Checks and completion of the Sport Integrity Australia [online induction](#).
2. Next complete the [PDGA Sanctioning Agreement](#):
 - Your event name must start with ADGC26 and should be a C-tier or higher.
 - Use coupon code **ADGD2026** at checkout to have all fees waived.
3. Once registered with PDGA, complete the [ADG Event Sanctioning Agreement](#)
 - fill in all the of event details and answer the questions
 - select **Aussie Disc Golf Day (ADGD)** under tournament format
 - you can elect to use the ADG online registration system or your own event managed registrations such as [DiscGolfScene](#) (additional fees apply).
4. Organise and promote your event as well as 50 Years of Flight on social media



Celebrating 50 Years of Flight

As we are celebrating the 50th anniversary of Flying Disc Sports in Australia, we are asking all events to promote the 50 Years of Flight event and for TD's to provide a short 60-second talk about the momentous occasion. Appropriate wording will be provided.

The 50 Years of Flight team have negotiated a deal with three awesome disc manufacturers allowing clubs or event organisers to order small quantities of the 50 Years of Flight discs. We will leave it up to TD's but they may want to offer these discs as an optional purchase, part of a player's pack or prizes for division winners. We encourage organisers to order discs early to allow time for stamping and shipping.
